

UK Sport Development Network/Sport and Recreation Alliance Partnership Agreement

The UK Sport Development Network has established a semi-formal partnership agreement with the Sport and Recreation Alliance (The Alliance) in which the 2 organisations work together for mutual benefit.

The partnership agreement operates in a spirit of informality, collaboration and trust as follows:

1. The Alliance's Director of Policy, Governance and External Affairs is a member of and contributes to the UKSDN's leadership group in an advisory role.
2. The Alliance communicates on a regular basis with the UKSDN to share upcoming priorities, including political and Parliamentary plans.
3. UKSDN provides critique, comment and challenge to The Alliance's work where appropriate.
4. UKSDN works with The Alliance to identify opportunities to host debate and dialogue, principally via The Alliance's and UKSDN's websites and digital communication channels.
5. The UKSDN and The Alliance mutually promote each other's programmes, research and events as far as is practically possible.
6. The Alliance offers UKSDN the opportunity to tender for projects, giving advance opportunities to bid as far as possible.
7. UKSDN members have the opportunity to approach The Alliance to partner on projects of mutual interest and benefit.
8. The Alliance identifies ongoing opportunities for UKSDN to provide comment, guest web content and, where appropriate, input to media work.

The agreement is reviewed and updated annually.
